## INFORMATION FROM THE DATA PROCESSING CENTER

## ACCESS HOURS WEEKEND W941

During the weekend of Friday, October 13th to Sunday, October 15th, Data Processing Center's access hours will be limited as follows. The times given are Swedish time. The customers which will primarily be affected are those in the V1-environment, i.e. Parts, Penta, Volvo Svenska Bil, VR (for dealers), Volvia and P2-Data.

V1-environment

The following is applicable for V1-environment customers (production and test environment). Production stop from Friday, October 13th at 6 p.m. to Sunday, October 15th at noon. After this the batch will be started. V1-environment is expected to be in full production at 7 a.m. on Monday, October 16th. Monday October 16th is a reserve day in case complications should arise.

V2-environment

For customers in the V2-environment, i.e. Cars, Trucks, Buses, Flygmotor and Volvo Transport, batch scheduled for Friday, October 13th from 6 p.m. to midnight will be delayed by 2-3 hours. This applies only to jobs which require tape handling.

VD02-environment

For customers in VD02-environment, i.e. Volvo Data Syd, VHQ and for some MEMO and VICS customers, there is risk of production stop on Saturday, October 14th from 9 p.m. to midnight.

All environments

During the weekend between Friday, October 13th 6 p.m. and Sunday, October 15th at noon local printouts will not be possible with the exception of MEMO and IMS.

File transfer and RJE transmissions from the V1-environment will be delayed during the production stop in the V1-environment.

The reason for our limited access hours during this weekend is that we will be rearranging our computer environments in order to achieve better capacity utilization. The dates have been agreed to by the customers concerned.

In case complications should arise, which makes it impossible to keep our schedule, we have appointed for each V1-environment customer, a contact man who will be at hand during the weekend. This contact man will be responsible for informing Volvo Data which applications have the greatest priority at your company.


Central printout

Owing to the above-mentioned rearrangement of computer environments, all central printouts will be carried out in the V2-environment. Dest-id NJOXR (XEROX, single-sheet printer) has been moved centrally. Those who use other dest-id which go to V1 and want to print centrally must, therefor, change to NJOXR. The change will be permanent.
